## FROM YOUR DIRECTORS

#### TRANSPORTATION

2021 was another challenging year for transportation, but with the support, cooperation, and flexibility of everyone involved, it was also a successful year! With over 600 CAMPERS to be safely transported between their homes and ARROWHEAD, we needed to greatly increase the number of vehicles over what we had last year. Our fleet consisted of 17 Vans, 12 72passenger school buses, 1 28-passenger bus, and a 9passenger minibus. One of the challenges we faced was securing the 17 vans. Due to the "chip shortage" that affected the entire automobile industry, we had to use 4 different vendors to secure those Vans, and even with that, not all of them were of the 15-passenger variety. This meant that we were rotating vehicles through various routes on an almost weekly basis. Fortunately, our incredible DRIVERS and MAINTENANCE CREW made all of those changes seamless.

We were also limited in the number of 72-passenger buses we could acquire. Normally this would have resulted in excessively long rides for many of our CAMPERS. However, with the introduction of our "Bus Stop Option," we were able to greatly reduce the number of stops required on many of our routes. This option provided PARENTS with a TUITION DISCOUNT if they would meet the bus at the home of a nearby CAMPER rather than requiring a separate stop at each home. This meant that on one of our routes we were able to cut the number of stops by 60%, greatly reducing travel time. The "Bus Stop Option," along with the TUITION DISCOUNT will be offered again for the 2022 season, so we encourage PARENTS to take advantage of it.

## UNCLE STEVE HOUDESHEL FOOD FOR THOUGHT

This summer was one like no other in the kitchen this year! We had to go from serving everyone family style, to a take-out model to follow all health and safety quidelines. Luckily our wonderful staff was up to the job! Plexiglas was all around the mess hall, staff ate outside and only 7 bunks were in the mess hall at one time opposed to 10 during normal times. But with all the changes it was still great seeing our happy campers eating and drinking everyday! We served our healthy options like salad, vogurt, turkey hot dogs, baked potato and hard boiled eggs everyday and it would not have been possible without our wonderful chefs Aunts Joanne M, Debbie and Joanne S. and our kitchen kids with AJ, Michael, Chris and Anthony. We were so excited for having a brand new air conditioner to keep our campers even cooler than last year! Can't wait for the summer and hopefully so more normalcy for all of us here at Arrowhead!

#### **AQUATIC UPDATE**

The instructional morning program uses the best teachings & techniques from the American Red Cross. We have 10 swim schools; teaching strokes from beginner through intermediate and up to advanced. As children progress through our system, swim cards are mailed home to show parents the skills mastered by your child. Children use their skills learned in the morning during afternoon swim, which is filled with fun as our intermediate and advanced swimmers use the water slides and diving board. Beginning swimmers gain confidence as they see how much fun the water can be. We especially enjoy club periods where campers come to play fun games with our lifeguards. The addition of swim group bracelets continued to be a hit! Keep safe and stay well. See you very soon!
