NATURE

We are having a wonderful time at Nature this summer exploring topics such as flowers, pinecones, the sun and rocks! We examined real flowers and identified their parts and then read about what flowers can be used for! Some bunks made good-smelling potpourri sachets and other bunks used flower stamps to design postcards. We learned that the sun is a very important star and then some campers made suncatchers out of plastic cups by decoupage tissue paper to the outside. Some bunks spent time learning about pine cones and matching each one on a chart of different types of "cones" from trees. Campers got to paint a pinecone and make "door decor." Lastly, we explored rocks! We learned that all rocks are made of minerals and some bunks learned the three different types of rocks and the characteristics of those. Many of our junior campers sorted rocks into categories, like big and small, rough and smooth, etc., and then we all got a chance to look at beautiful crystals and gemstones. Several bunks made "rock buddies" while others created "rock gardens" to take home with them. Not only are we learning about these exciting nature concepts, but we are also getting a chance to enjoy and take care of our animals! All of our pets have been adopted and given to camp. They include three guinea pigs (Roxi, Lola and James), a red-eared slider turtle (Colson), two hermit crabs (Coco and Rock Steady) and a gecko (Snuggles) thanks to Aunt Marty! Looking forward to so much more learning and exploring the rest of the summer!

All food is served "family style" by our Jr. Counselors & is available in our delightfully air conditioned Mess Hall. For those campers who do not care for the main meal of the day we always have available daily – soy peanut butter & jelly & marshmallow fluff (in any combination) on fresh whole wheat bread, hard boiled eggs, baked potatoes, buttered pasta, fresh sliced NY bagels with cream cheese, cereal, & grilled hotdogs with all the fixins'. Mixed green salad and yogurt will be served in individual containers.

LIQUID REFRESHMENT- All campers will have a variety of flavors of Arrowhead's world famous ice-cold bug juice served during lunchtime in unlimited quantities- (Monday thru Thursday). Lemonade is served to all campers every Friday.

SNACK- All campers (JR, INT & SR) receive their daily snack in the afternoon which includes special treats (cookies, pretzels, fresh fruit)
