TRANSPORTATION

Transportation Department once again had some lastminute issues when one of our suppliers let us know the week before Camp started that they would not be able to get us the 15-passenger vans they had promised. However, thanks to Uncle Brian the crisis was avoided, and things ran smoothly from then on!

Once again, our BUS STOP option was utilized by many families which greatly streamlined some of our largest routes. Thank you to those parents who took advantage of this! We have seen an annual increase in the number of families taking advantage of this which has made our job much easier.

As we look forward to the 2024 Season, we have already completed much of the work planning out the routes and assigning Campers to our various forms of Transportation. We have also secured the necessary number of 15-passenger vans from our most reliable source to avoid the problems we've had over the past two years. We are planning on utilizing 18 total buses (28-, 48-, and 72-passenger), 19 15-passenger vans and 3 minivans. These numbers will necessitate the expansion of the paved area for our "Van Parking Lot," but will be well worth it. As many of you continue to share by word-of-mouth and Social Media your positive experiences with ARROWHEAD, our enrollment remains strong. Your continued support will assure that ARROWHEAD remains "A Child's Paradise!"
