The BUS STOP option continues to grow in popularity, allowing us to make our routes more efficient and timelier while still allowing us to maximize our capacity. Thank you again to all of you who take the opportunity to select this option!

With our registration being completed early in September, we were able to get our basic routes laid out and reserve the needed 15-passenger vans by the middle of October. We are again at our maximum capacity, so securing these vehicles well in advance is an absolute necessity.
